CRITERIA: Submissions will be adjudicated according to the following criteria:

- a) Significance of the problem addressed
- b) The conceptualization and design of the research
- c) The potential value of the research for theory development, improved practice and future research in comparative and international education
- d) Writing quality

AWARD WINNERS will receive:

- a) Certificate of Accomplishment presented at the CSSE Conference;
- b) Cash award
- c) Andrew Skinner stipend for travel to attend CSSE 2023
- d) Complimentary membership to CIESC

SUBMISSION: Using the google form links below, candidates will submit

- 2.) An electronic copy (e.g., pdf) of their thesis
- 3.) A short summary/overview of the thesis of no longer than 15 pages (including references). This can directly draw from sections of the thesis' introduction and conclusion.
